This newly refurbished apartment with terrace is located in the CENTRE OF PALMA DE MALLORCA. The building is situated ON A SQUARE and there is no car traffic in front of it (PEDESTRIAN ZONE). It is a lively neighbourhood with its own market hall close-by, many shops and good restaurants. The old town is only 300 m away.

The building with lovely historical details dates from 1935. All flats have high ceilings and large windows on two sides, with a lot of light coming in from the sunny square. The building and all units have just been COMPLETELY REFURBISHED (first occupancy). A lift has been installed.

Offered here is Apartment 1C on the 1st floor. It is a SPACIOUS APARTMENT (approx. 94m²) with 3 bedrooms, 2 small balconies as well as 1 covered terrace (10m²) and 1 large PRIVATE TERRACE (32m²) at the back of the house.
